Much of the lunch, dinner, and weekend-brunch vegetable ingredients are grown on the rooftop's aeroponic garden, overseen by Chef John Mooney of New York City's Bell Book & Candle.

Insider Tip: Bite into an heirloom melon created by the restaurant's namesake, U.S. General John Bidwell, also a 19th-century agriculturist..
